Replacement coverage for fake auto insurance

The Michigan Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation directed Fender Bender Insurance Agency to cease its operations in the state. The commissioner warned consumers that they may have purchased fake auto insurance certificates from the company. He warned consumers who purchased any insurance certificates from the company to find legitimate replacement coverage immediately. Consumers were reminded to verify if an agency is licensed to do business in the state prior to purchasing coverage.
